This is a sure fire way to distract people from just how good they currently are and leave members and guests with a bitter taste in their mouths. Please repair your pitchmarks on the green. If you see another pitchmark near yours then fix that as well. Hold your playing partners to the same high standard.

Off the yellow tees for the ladies the 3<sup>rd</sup> was the hardest averaging 2.31 strokes over par. For both sets of tees the 11<sup>th</sup> was playing the easiest.
